An important new digital initiative from the Getty: The <u>Getty Research Portal</u> has created <u>an overview</u> <u>and tutorial video</u> in response to the pandemic and a need to switch to remote teaching and learning. The video, which is approximately 10 minutes long, provides a brief introduction to the Portal's background and virtual holdings, and demonstrates how to use it. The Portal is a free online search platform that provides access to digitized volumes on art, architecture, material culture, and related fields. With 180,000 volumes contributed by <u>nearly forty international art libraries and museums</u> at present, the Portal offers literature ranging from rare early publications to contemporary catalogs.
