Allen, Isabel. "Soho Place". Architecture Today. (November/December, 2022). p.56-73.

"Soho Place is the outcome of two decades of collaboration with our longest standing client, Derwent London, joined in 2010 by Nimax, which turned our duo into a trio. The project began before Crossrail was certain, with a masterplan which established the project principles. Two buildings frame a new public space, another trio and a new piece of city all set over one of the most complex webs of tunnels and stations in London" (62).

Dunmall, Giovanna. "Micro Manager". Azure. (November/December, 2022). p.50-53.

"Intended for 20- to 45-year-olds who don't have many options in Ecuador Váscone if they want to live alone or as a couple, the first Doméstico was made for a channel "N apartment in the new Oorner tower in Quito (a project by local developer design and Uribe Schwarzkopf and Sadie Architects). The city is growing fast, says the pair, and its economic center (as opposed to its historic district) is becoming very diverse, with colleges, activities and public spaces" (53).

Galiano, Luis. "Casa Pitaya, Mindo". AV Monographs, 2022. Issue 247. p.78-83.

"The house is meant to be flexible, adequately serving the family but also able to accommodate more users and diverse activities. Taking advantage of the climate of Mindo, the conditions established for the family are not necessarily the same as for the visitors, who can occupy the space in a more informal way. The house includes a number of 'capsules' that can be isolated while maintaining good comfort conditions, with many intermediate spaces that can be adapted to need. These spaces also serve as circulation areas, with privileged views and infinite ways of occupying the house" (78).

"Still, though highly lauded and people-pleasing, none of Sadie's recent victory-lap projects have been low carbon ventures. He is adamant about refusing to greenwash anything. As Lubin puts it: 'Construction is by definition extremely damaging to the environment. We like to talk about resilience and timelessness.' Indeed, nowhere in Safdie's more-than-350-page memoir does he ever mention climate change, global warming, or carbon emissions" (128).

"Early in the design process, Rockcastle presented the dients with images of distinct Minnesotan landscapes grafted onto their lot. "In the striking new pavilion at Japan's Yashima Mountain Top Park, the voids are as essential as the solids. Clad with scaly stone shingles, the structure's sinuous form snakes its way around the site, defining six gardens that capitalize on spectacular vistas of the Set Inland Sea and Shikoku island's mild climate. The project is the product of Takashi Suo, who worked for the Tokyo architect Kazuyo Scima as well as SANAA for nine years before launching his Kyoto-based practice in 2015" (45).
